1. Solve each of the following systems of equations using Gaussian elimination and back-substitution. If a solution exists, express it as a vector or a linear combination of vectors.

$$(a) \quad \left. \begin{array}{l} x + y + 6z = -5 \\ 4x - 2y - 3z = 1 \\ -2x + y + 2z = 0 \end{array} \right\}$$

$$(b) \quad \left. \begin{array}{l} x_1 - x_2 + 4x_3 = 5 \\ -x_1 + 3x_2 - 6x_3 = -13 \\ x_1 + x_2 + 2x_3 = -3 \end{array} \right\}$$

$$(c) \quad \left. \begin{array}{l} 2x + 6y - 4z = 4 \\ -3x - 4y + z = -6 \\ -x + 2y - 3z = 2 \end{array} \right\}$$

$$(d) \quad \left. \begin{array}{l} x_1 + 2x_2 - x_4 = 8 \\ 3x_1 + 6x_2 + x_3 - 2x_4 = 23 \\ x_3 + x_4 = -1 \end{array} \right\}$$

$$(e) \quad \left. \begin{array}{l} 3x_1 + x_2 - 5x_3 + 2x_4 = 2 \\ -2x_2 + x_3 - x_4 = -10 \\ x_1 + 4x_2 - 4x_3 + 8x_4 = 8 \\ -3x_1 - x_2 + 7x_3 = -6 \end{array} \right\}$$

2. Determine the conditions on p and q such that the following system has no solutions:

$$\left. \begin{array}{l} x - 3y - 5z = p \\ 4x - 10y - 16z = 0 \\ -4y - 8z = q. \end{array} \right\}$$

3. Find a polynomial $p(x)$ of degree 2 that passes through the points $(1, -4)$, $(-1, -12)$ and $(4, -7)$, by setting up a system of equations, then using Gaussian elimination and back-substitution.
