INFORMATION 2010 - Paton College

ACCOMMODATIONS: A single room is comprised of one twin bed. A double room is comprised of two twin beds. Rooms have a desk, chair and a closet with drawers. Bedding, towels, face cloth and soap are provided. There is no telephone or TV in the bedrooms.

PAYMENT: You are required to provide credit card information prior to your arrival

REGISTRATION: No matter how you arrive in St. John's you have to come to Hatcher House (refer to **Map of the Campus** below for location) at the University to register for your accommodations. The booth is open 24 hours a day, seven days a week (**(Under review)**. The University is about 10 – 15 minutes from St. John's Airport.

KEYS: Keys <u>MUST</u> be returned to the reservations booth in Hatcher prior to your departure. <u>NOTE</u>: Failure to do so will result in a \$100.00 charge on your credit card.

CHECK-IN / CHECK-OUT: Check-in time is after 3:00pm. Check-out time is by 11:00am

PETS: NO pets allowed under any circumstances.

WASHROOMS: There are two common washrooms on each floor – one female and one male.

LAUNDROMAT: There is a laundromat in each residence accessible 24 hours a day. Swipe card required and card (\$2.00 charge) available in Hatcher House outside reservations booth.

SECURITY: The residence buildings are locked twenty-four hours a day.

PARKING: A parking permit is required for those with private vehicles. Permits are available at the conference reservations booth in Hatcher House for a nominal fee of \$4.00/day.

TELEPHONES: Pay telephone is located in most residences

WIRELESS LAN: Guests can apply for temporary access to the wireless local area network. Check at the reservations desk upon arrival for additional information.

ALCOHOL: Is permitted for personal consumption in bedrooms only. Individuals must be at least nineteen years of age to purchase and consume alcohol in the province of Newfoundland and Labrador. Beer must be purchased in cans only. No beer bottles permitted.

SMOKING: The campus of Memorial University of Newfoundland is smoke free. Smoking is not permitted in the bedrooms.
