

## PATERNAL PEDIGREE INFORMATION

In order to publish information about your paternal pedigree in association with your test results, you can print and fill in as many copies of the following page as are necessary. All that is required is the information for your direct paternal lineage (the information collected for spouses/partners is mostly to help describe your direct male ancestors).

Some helpful things that you can do when completing the form:

- Use 4-digit years (eg. 1772 instead of '72)
- Spell out all months, in order to avoid ambiguities such as 02-11 (which could be interpreted as either 02 November or 11 February)
- For persons who are still alive, please write “*Still Alive*” in the area for death information.
- For persons who are deceased, but you don't have their death information, please write “*Deceased*” so that I at least know that this is the case.
- Please print neatly.
