Fisherman's cove, Eastern passage 20 min drive	Fishing harbour, next to Lawlor Island which was the quarantine station at one time, little shops, short board walk	Paddle or fishing boat to McNab's island	Boat rental available at Fishermans' cove Fascinating historic site
York Rebout 20 min	National historic site Easy parking, great views and interesting history	"Lower" York Rebout	access via tunnel on east side, one can walk down to the cliffs on a regular, but steep path
Dingle, Flemming Tower 15 min	Easy parking, easy walk along the NW Arm	Extended walk from Dingle up to the Frog Pond	One hour walk through lovely nature
Peggy's cove 40 min	Atlantic Canada's landmark , brand new accessible easy walk, but usually busy	Polly's cove	Great walk, at times a bit steep, super views of Peggy's cove but w/o the tourists
Burntcoat provincial park 90 min	Longish drive to the Bay of Fundy, where one can walk at the ocean floor at low tide	Tidal Bore rafting trip	Great fun, especially during full moon when the tides are high, one will get WET and muddy ...
Lunenburg 50 min	Unesco World Heritage site, boat building site, restaurants,	The Ovens	Walk along the cliffs near Lunenburg
Wolfville 40 min	University town near the mudflats, little shops and restaurants, vineries,	Cape Split	Great hike (3-4 hours) to the cliffs overlooking the bay of Fundy , once needs good shoes
Crystal Crescent beach 30 min	Good parking, three sand beaches but the water is cold	Hike along the shore	The last beach has 'clothing optional", once can go further along the cliffs
Chebucto Head Lighthouse	Short distance from Halifax, short walk on	Duncan's cove	Great hike just off the same road, one

20 min	paved road to old lighthouse		needs good shoes, it's at times muddy and steep, unbeatable views!
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
