WeBWorK Information

An important part of your evaluation in Math 1000 will consist of a series of problem sets that you'll complete through WeBWorK, an online homework system. WeBWorK gives you instant feedback so that you can determine which topics you understand well, and which topics may benefit from extra help via your instructor or the Math Help Centre.

WeBWorK will be automatically set up for you early in the semester, and a “GettingStarted” problem set will immediately become available. You should work through “GettingStarted” so that you become comfortable answering different types of questions.

How to use WeBWorK

The information on the right side of the page when you access a problem set will give you the due date and target mark for that problem set. If you match or exceed the target mark, you'll earn a Pass on the problem set. If you don't achieve the target mark on your first attempt, you can try new versions of the questions you got wrong, and you can do this as many times as necessary prior to the due date. As long as you reach the target mark before the deadline, you'll still earn a Pass on that problem set. Your final WeBWorK grade will be determined by the number of Passes you earned, divided by the total number of problem sets that have been assigned.
